

Grade Level Promotion

- To satisfy promotion requirements, a student must attend a minimum of 167 days of school.
- Students in 6th, 7th, and 8th grades in EBR Schools have 8 classes per semester for a total of 16 grades received between the two semesters. Students must receive a minimum of 13 of 16 passing grades in order to be promoted to the next grade.
- A student should not be retained more than one time for failure to meet academic requirements in grades 6–8.
- Eighth grade students shall score at least at the “Basic” achievement level in either English language arts or mathematics and “Approaching Basic” in the other subject in order to be promoted to the ninth grade. Students who do not meet the promotion standard after taking the eighth grade state assessments in the spring may be placed on a high school campus in the transitional ninth grade.
